

This fabulous 400 year old "Maple Cottage" is set in the hamlet of Beanthwaite, and is an ideal opportunity to acquire a truly beautiful home that oozes character, charm and history at every turn.

This once Coaching Inn is set in a most beautiful position, boasting stunning Lakeland views, and offers spacious living accommodation, and sizeable garden areas to enjoy.

On approach, there is a drive leading to a spacious double garage. Through the wrought iron gate and a pretty front garden is the front entrance to the house, which opens to the lounge area.

The room is full of character, with its open fireplace, wood beams and floors and three windows with beautiful views to the surrounding Lakeland fells. The country kitchen is accessed down a flight of stairs at the end of the lounge.

The kitchen is a stunning room, with exposed beams, stone walls, an open pantry, range cooker and a lovely dining area.
